ARTICLEI

The exect name of the corporation is:

ARTICLEII

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the following activities:

The specific objectives and purposes of this corporation shall be:

- A. To educate the public and disseminate information about aquatic plants.
- B. To study and improve upon techniques for sulfuting aquetic and bog plants in equations and ponds.
- C. To increase interest in aquatic gardening.

And to carry on any other business or activity which may be lawfully carried on by a corporation organized under Chapter 180 of the General Laws in the furtherance of the purposes set forth above.

ARTICLE IV

"Other lawful provisions, if any, for the conduct and regulation of the business and office of the corporation, for its voluntary dissolution, or for limiting, defining, or regulating the powers of the corporation, or of its directors or members, or of any class of members, are as follows:

AFFILIATED TRANSACTIONS

A. Validity. Except as otherwise provided in these Articles, if paragraph B is satisfied, no contract or transaction between the Corporation and any of its directors or officers or any corporation, parmership, association or other organization in which any of such directors or officers are directly or indirectly financially interested, shall be void or voidable solely because of this relationship, or solely because of the presence of the director or officer at the meeting authorizing the contract or transaction, or solely because of his or their participation in the authorization of such contract or transaction or vote was necessary for the authorization of such contract or transaction.

B. Disclosure, Approval; Fairness. Paregraph A shall apply only if:

- 1. the material facts as to the relationship or interest and as to the contract or transaction are disclosed or are known to the board of directors (or a committee thereof) and it nevertheless in good faith authorizes or ratifies the contract or transaction by a majority of the directors present, each such interested director to be counted in determining whether a quorum is present but not in calculating the majority necessary to carry the vote; and
- 2. the contract or transaction is fair to the Corporation as of the time it is authorized or ratified by the board of directors (or committee thereof).

ARTICLE V

The hy-laws of the corporation have been duly adopted and the initial directors, president, treasurer and clerk or other presiding, financial or recording officers, whose names are set out on the following page, have been duly elected.
